An Act to amend the Administration of Islamic Law (Federal Territories) Act 1993.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Malaysia as follows:

Short title and commencement

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Administration of Islamic Law (Federal Territories) (Amendment) (No. 2) Act 2019.
- (2) This Act comes into operation on a date to be appointed by the Yang di-Pertuan Agong by notification in the *Gazette*.

Amendment of section 2

2. The Administration of Islamic Law (Federal Territories) Act 1993 [Act 505], which is referred to as the "principal Act" in this Act, is amended in section 2 by deleting the definition of "Peguam Syarie".

Deletion of section 59

3. The principal Act is amended by deleting section 59.

Saving and transitional

- **4.** (1) Any application by any person for an admission as a *Peguam Syarie*, or objection to such application or an admission as a *Peguam Syarie*, or appeal against the decision relating to the application for admission, or disciplinary proceedings relating to *Peguam Syarie*, pending before the coming into operation of this Act shall be dealt with under the principal Act as if the principal Act had not been amended.
- (2) On the date of coming into operation of this Act, any *Sijil Peguam Syarie* issued under the principal Act before the coming into operation of this Act and is still valid, and any *Sijil Peguam Syarie* issued for the purpose of subsection (1), shall be subjected to the *Syarie* Legal Profession (Federal Territories) Act 2019 [Act].

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Bill seeks to amend the Administration of Islamic Law (Federal Territories) Act 1993 ("Act 505").

- 2. Clause 1 contains the short title and the provision on the date of commencement of the proposed Act.
- 3. Clause 2 seeks to delete the definition of "Peguam Syarie" consequential to the deletion of section 59 of Act 505 in clause 3.
- 4. Clause 3 seeks to delete section 59 of Act 505 to remove the provision on the powers of the Majlis in matters relating to *Peguam Syarie*. This deletion is in consequence of the enactment of the proposed *Syarie* Legal Profession (Federal Territories) Act 2019. Matters relating to *Peguam Syarie* will be provided in the proposed *Syarie* Legal Profession (Federal Territories) Act 2019.
- 5. Clause 4 contains saving and transitional provisions.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

This Bill will not involve the Government in any extra financial expenditure.
