An Act to amend the Energy Commission Act 2001.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Malaysia as follows:

Short title and commencement

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the Energy Commission (Amendment) Act 2025.

(2) This Act comes into operation on a date to be appointed by the Minister by notification in the *Gazette*.

Amendment of section 14

2. The Energy Commission Act 2001 [*Act 610*] is amended in subsection 14(1)—

(a) in paragraph (n), by deleting the word “and” at the end of the paragraph; and

(b) by inserting after paragraph (n) the following paragraph:

“(na) to exercise regulatory functions in respect of the importation of electricity and exportation of electricity; and”.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Bill seeks to amend the Energy Commission Act 2001 (“Act 610”) following the amendments to the Electricity Supply Act 1990 [Act 447]. Through the proposed amendments to Act 447, the Commission is charged with a regulatory function over the importation of electricity and exportation of electricity.

2. *Clause 1* contains the short title and the provision on the commencement of the proposed Act.

3. *Clause 2* seeks to amend subsection 14(1) of Act 610 by introducing new paragraph 14(1)(na) into Act 610. With this proposed amendment, the Commission is charged with a regulatory function over the importation of electricity and exportation of electricity.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

This Bill will involve the Government in extra financial expenditure the amount of which cannot at present be ascertained.
